## LOCKER SHELVES:

If you wish to purchase locker shelves, it is important to buy adjustable ones. The inside dimensions of our lockers are $\mathbf{1 0 \prime \prime} \times 1 \mathbf{1 0}^{\prime \prime}$ and standard metal shelves or locker ladders don't fit correctly and cause the doors to jam and the mechanism to break.

All student belongings need to be kept locked, in student lockers. Backpacks with wheels do not fit into the middle school lockers, so please do not purchase backpacks with wheels.
